Former NASA Astronaut John "Danny" Olivas (STS 117 and STS 128), who helped devise a way to fix the space shuttle for the first time in orbit, will talk about the wonders of space travel, and the importance of exploring one's passions. Olivas is special assistant to the dean of engineering at the University of Texas at El Paso, a forensic engineer, and author of *Endeavour's Long Journey*, which encourages young students to become scientists, engineers, and explorers.
