Kenya-born Sarah Anindo Marshall, a Certified Dunham Technique Instructor and

a member of the Katherine Dunham Certification Board, studied West African dance with Kimoko Samo, formerly artistic director of Guinea's Les Ballet Africains. Anindo Marshall has taught at the Debbie Allen Dance Academy, Dance Dimensions, University of Southern California, Lula Washington Dance Theater, and Dallas Black Dance Theater, among others, and is also a vocalist and a percussionist who studied with renowned percussionists such as Babatunde Olatunji and Mamadi Keita. She will lead a class that explores the richness of African Dance traditions, focusing on West African Djembe and Central African. *If participating, wear appropriate black on black dancewear.*

Denise Leitner, internationally known as a choreographer for stage, screen, television, and music videos, is the founder of

critically acclaimed Dancer's Voice, which performs at dance festivals worldwide. She conducts workshops and master classes throughout the United States and abroad, trains dancers to work in a variety of entertainment media, has worked with Bjork and Nona Hendrix, and privately coaches performing artists such as Kate Hudson and Topher Grace.
