## Santa Monica College

Interaction Design (IxD) is more than designing for the web and mobile devices. It's not confined to interaction with a mouse or touchscreen. Interaction Design is designing for behavior. It's user-centered design for how we interact with objects and systems. Interaction Design focuses on the behavior of the device or product, as well as the user. User-centered design considers the needs and desires of the user.
