II. Public Comments and Announcements

- a. Tom Briskey, an adjunct kinesiology professor, introduced himself. A PhD student in Global Leadership, Tom is looking to be part of an initiative that matches his program's focus.
- b. Delphine summarized her time at the Curriculum Committee (along with Pete, Denise and Sri). Last week, members of the GC Committee were encouraged by Eric Minzenberg to attend the Curriculum Committee meeting to make a public comment about the importance of keeping Global Citizenship as a requirement for the A.A. degree.
- c. Delphine also updated the Committee members about the unanimous vote on the Global Citizenship resolution brought forth to the Executive Committee on March 19, 2024. Before proceeding with the resolution, Delphine was encouraged by the Executive Committee to 1) speak with members of the vision/mission taskforce; 2) partner with the Environmental Affairs Committee (which finds itself in a similar position). The Committee briefly discussed potential conferences its members could attend with this year's funds. Upon further reflection, the Committee members decided to research conferences on their own time and return next meeting with conference ideas.

e. Study Abroad

Denise updated the Committee about her meetings with George Davison (Japan – Winter 2025) and Heather Bennett (Polynesia – Summer 2025). Taneka Washington briefly spoke about her prep for the upcoming study abroad trip to Florence during spring break.
