b. Global Grants Presentations for Spring 2023

The committee received 6 Global Grant proposals for Spring 2023. The author of each proposal was invited to speak about their request and answer questions from the Committee.

i. Women's Movement in Iran- Elham Gheytauchi, Philosophy and Social Sciences

Proposal \$1,000: One speaker to present during class via zoom

Plans to invite an Iran Expert, Ms. Roya Hakakian to give a presentation about women's movement in Iran now. This talk will take place in my online class (sociology 1) via Zoom and will be open to all SMC community.

The committee approved \$3,000 for speaker to be in-person and have this be a community event instead of classroom lecture. Motion: Kinsella. Second: Locke. Approval: Unanimous

- ii. Primary Care Shortage Crisis- Collin Ellis, Life Sciences  
Proposal for \$600  
Create an interactive workshop and speaker panel for our students, whom are the future of healthcare, to help them to understand this crisis and hopefully be motivated to go into primary care specialties in underserved communities. This panel would include local primary care clinicians that can discuss the crisis and what is being done to address it on a national and international level. Motion: Kinsella. Second: Locke. - iii. Celebrating Cesar Chavez and Dolores Huerta- John Quevedo  
Proposal for \$1,600  
Live mariachi music and dance performance from Global Motion to celebrate LatinX Leaders Cesar Chavez and Dolores Huerta on Cesar Chavez Day.

- iv. Santa Monica Water Recycling- Glen Chung, Physical Sciences  
Proposal \$3,000  
design and to fabricate a free-standing, hands-on exhibit for display inside the SMC library. We already have informal, non-contractual permission from Walter Butler, head of the campus library for this display (if funded). The exhibit will feature models and posters of the water recycling, groundwater wells, and water treatment facilities in use by the city of Santa Monica. One model and two posters have already been made and used by the city; these will be donated to this project (if funded) by the city's water department, with permission from Mr. Sunny Wang, city water resources

- v. Spring Community Read- Shannon Herbert, English  
Proposal for \$3,000  
As part of Matika Wilbur's historic residency at SMC, we will be holding a Community Read of her forthcoming book Project 562. Each of the Community Reads will be held in the Barrett Gallery to further invite people into the space to experience and activate the installation. Each Community Read event will be facilitated by different members of our community--including the students who printed, built, and installed the show--as well as a member of the Tongva community, L Frank, who is featured in the book.

vi. Global Indigeneity- Brianna Simmons, Art

Proposal for \$3,000 for two speakers at \$1,500 each.

The Art Department requests funding to host a one-day conference for the SMC community. We are asking for \$3000 to pay UCLA professors Dr. Raul Hinojosa-Ojeda and Dr. Desi Small Rodriguez to organize and facilitate this conference. The impetus for this conference came from a conversation with Dr. Hinojosa-Ojeda and Dr. Small Rodriguez, who attended Matika Wilbur's SMC keynote on October 11, 2022, and were enthralled with the idea of SMC leading this conversation.

The committee approves this grant for \$1,300
