#### III. Announcements/Updates/Action Items

a. Motion by Gordon Dossett

c. Gordon Dossett attended the Annual IIE Best Practices in International Education Conference on March 11, 2016 at UC Davis. The keynote speaker, Jewell Winn, from Tennessee State University was exceptional. Tennessee State has many programs to foster their international students such as academic and community mentorships and exchange study programs with other countries. Gordon mentioned we might consider bringing Ms. Winn to SMC.
