 - a. Global Council Standing Rules for 2017–18
 1. The committee shall consist of nine voting members: six faculty approved by the Academic Senate and three administrators.
 2. Five or more of the committee’s nine voting members shall constitute a quorum
 3. Meetings are open to the public. Official committee actions, such as making and seconding motions, and voting on formal action items, are exclusive to official voting members.
