I. Global Research Symposium Spring 2019

Delphine Broccard provided an update on the Global Citizenship Symposium scheduled for May 2019. This will be her fourth year as chair and she announced that she will be stepping down as chair after this symposium. She is starting to advertise the symposium to students now and needs help from committee members to promote the symposium in their departments. 6. Social Justice Sewing Academy, Professor Briana Simmons, Art, \$1500
