Proposal for \$4500: 18 Speakers at \$250 each for Sustainability courses

The Committee approved \$1800 for nine speakers at \$200 each. Motion: Weir. Second: Reilly. Approval: Unanimous

- iii. Spring Green Screen Film Series- Sheila Laffey, Comm/Film Studies
Proposal for \$1650: Speakers for three presentations (\$900), Online screening fees for 3 films (\$750)

The Committee approved \$1300 for this proposal: Online screening fees for 3 films (\$600), Speaker fees (\$700). Motion: Locke. Second: Susilowati. Approval: Unanimous.

- iv. Student Greening Workshops – Ferris Kavar, Sustainability
Proposal for \$3000 (two 8-week Student Sustainability Workshops)
The Committee approved \$1500 for this proposal. Motion: Kinsella. Second: Bennett. Approval: Unanimous

- v. Campus Indoor Air Quality Grid + Multi-Scale Data Collection – Alexandra Tower, Life Sciences

Proposal for \$2265.00 (10 Indoor air quality monitors)
