The Committee also discussed deliverables of GC-sponsored events (i.e., photos, recordings, etc.) and reviews of the events (surveys, student feedback, etc.).

c. Global Citizenship Symposium

The GC Symposium is to be held on May 5th. The deadline for submissions was extended to Friday April 1st at noon.



Suggestions for advertising included: promoting the event in faculty classes, speaking about the Symposium at meetings and events that faculty/staff attend and suggesting to other faculty that they offer extra credit to students who apply.

The judging timeline is that GC judges return their results between April 8th and April 18th. Delphine will meet with Dr Jeffery on April 25th.

The committee discussed the possibility of making the GC Symposium a hybrid event. However, Committee members expressed preference for keeping it fully online. Instead, they are considering doing an on-ground "launch party" to promote upcoming GC theme. That is still yet to be determined.

d. Spotlighting Student Work

GC members were sent samples of student work to review. After discussion the members decided to post three entries on the "Spotlighting Student Work" webpage.

The Committee will discuss the GC theme for 2022-2024 at the next meeting before opening it up to campus community for suggestions.
