(Kimberly Kokado, ICC General Account: \$112.50, Club Special Account: \$112.50, Student *Contribution:* \$90.00) A.S. President moved to approve action item 6.6, Seconded Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and action item 6.6 was approved, Unanimously 6.7 Approval of funding for the Writers Club to publish a book of poetry, including printing costs for 100 pages and higher quality cover printing. (Chase Maser, ICC Allotment: \$500.00, ICC General Account: \$1500.00) A.S. President moved to approve action item 6.7, Seconded Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and action item 6.7 was approved Unanimously **6.8** Approval of funding for the Eco Action Club to host a Joshua Tree camping trip for **1315** students and 1 advisor, including 34 national park entrance passes, campsite fee, firewood, tent, food, and supplies, contingent upon satisfactory completion of Inventory Form and Field Trip Form. (Lauren Hollenstien, ICC Allotment: \$466.41\$461.41, ICC General Account: \$466.41\$461.41) Director of Sustainability moved to approve action item 6.8, Seconded Associate Dean of Student Life moved to amend the language of action item 6.8, changing 3 national park passes to 4 and reducing the amount from each account to \$461.41, Seconded Without objection, the amendment passed ICC Vice Chair moved to amend the language of action item 6.8, adding "contingent upon satisfactory completion of Inventory Form and Field Trip Form", and changing 13 students to 15, Seconded Without objection, the amendment **passed** Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and the amended action item 6.8 was approved Unanimously

(Julio Santizo, ICC Allotment: \$125.00, ICC General Account: \$300.00) A.S. President moved to approve action item 6.10, Seconded A.S. President moved to bundle action items 6.10 and 6.11, Seconded Without objection, the motion passed A.S. President moved to amend action items 6.10 and 6.11, striking "and 5 \$25 gift cards," and reducing the amounts from the ICC General Account to \$175 for action item 6.10 and to \$25 for action item 6.11, Seconded Without objection, the amendment passed Director of Activities pointed out that the final performance (6.11) is on Thanksgiving. ICC Vice Chair moved to unbundle action items 6.10 and 6.11, Seconded Without objection, the motion **passed** A.S. President discussed incomplete proposal: some mistakes and inconsistencies, plus no club representative. ICC Vice Chair defended clubs' effort to learn the proposal process and pointed out that Opera Club is doing good work related to their mission. Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and action item 6.10 failed, with 4 nays and 1 aye by the ICC Vice Chair 6.11 Approval of funding for the Opera Club to put on a final performance on November 26th, including honorariums and 5 \$25 gift cards. (Julio Santizo, ICC Allotment: \$125.00, ICC General Account: \$150.00) A.S. President moved to approve action item 6.11, Seconded Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and action item 6.11 failed, with 4 nays and 1 aye by the ICC Vice Chair 6.12 Approval of funding for the A.S. to purchase 500 reusable utensil kits consisting of a fork, knife, spoon, and chopsticks, contingent upon verification of sufficient funds in the Sustainability Account. (Heather Haro, Sustainability: \$3295.00) ICC Vice Chair moved to approve action item 6.12, Seconded Associate Dean of Student Life moved to amend the language of action item 6.12, adding "contingent upon verification of sufficient funds in the Sustainability Account," Seconded Without objection, the amendment passed

Without objection, a roll call vote was taken and the amended action item 6.12 *was approved* <u>Unanimously</u>
