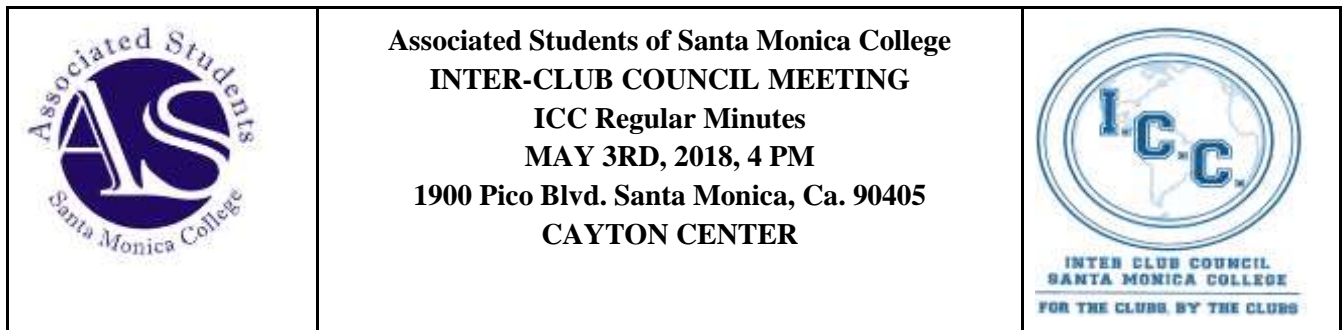
**5.3 Michael Brown- SMC GO APP**
