

Club must read on own. Half of the page is the health permit information. All the forms that are related to club row on Wednesday October 11, at 4pm office of student life to Michelle.

Questions: Will clubs be sharing tables?

Club Awareness has always shared tables, that was a rule. Club Row everyone will receive their own tables.

May we put up canopies?

Clubs serving food A.S will be providing your own canopy, clubs with health permit. The health permit states that it is mandatory that clubs serving food (with health permit) they will be needing canopies, which the ICC will be providing tents because specific restriction like the side





walls and wash station. Canopies will be provided for those clubs in specifically who have been issued to distribute food on the day of the event






