



Articulation Agreement KANSAS CITY ART INSTITUTE

For the areas of painting and printmaking, Kansas City Art Institute will accept students from Santa Monica College as full-time students with junior standing as provided under the following agreement:

1. GENERAL PROVISIONS:

- a. Transfer students must meet all general requirements for admission to KCAI as indicated in the KCAI catalogue, except that a portfolio review will not be required for students transferring under the provision of this agreement.
- b. Students transferring under this agreement must have a recommendation from the chair or dean of the appropriate department at Santa Monica College.
- c. KCAI will provide one merit scholarship per year designated as for “Santa Monica College Merit Scholarship” with additional scholarships possible depending on the number of Santa Monica students applying to KCAI. The probable amount of the merit scholarship will be between \$6,000.00 and \$7,000.00.

4. GENERAL EDUCATION

Completion of either the CSU General Education Requirements or the IGETC count as fulfilling 27 hours of KCAI Liberal Arts credit, and as satisfying the distribution requirements. KCAI highly recommends that students satisfying the CSU or IGETC requirements take 6 units in Art History as part of their arts requirement. The transferring student would then be required to successfully complete 9 credit hours in upper-division Art History electives as KCAI, and 9 credit hours in upper-division Humanities electives at KCAI.

This agreement will remain in effect until cancelled by the Kansas City Art Institute.
