- The courses listed on the Advising Guide are currently transferable under the 2010 SCAD course catalog for specific SCAD requirements for the Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography.
- Students are subject to the requirements of the SCAD course catalog in effect at the time of his or her entry and registration at SCAD. Students may choose to fulfill requirements of any subsequent SCAD course catalog within five years of their first enrollment at SCAD.
- This document is specific to the Santa Monica College Associate in Arts Degree, Photography and the Savannah College of Art and Design's Bachelor of Fine Arts in Photography.
- In order for a course to be considered for transfer, it must be at least three semester credit hours or five quarter hours. A grade of "C" or higher must be earned in the class. A course transferred from the Santa Monica College may fulfill only one SCAD course requirement.
- A maximum of 18 courses may transfer into the SCAD BFA program of study.
- Credit awarded by another college or university for Advanced Placement, A-Level, AS-Level, CAPE, CLEP, DANTES/DSST, French Baccalaureate, German Abitur, and International Baccalaureate is not transferable without proper documentation. Official scores must be submitted to the SCAD office of admission.
- In some instances, a student's course selection may fulfill a different requirement than listed on the Guide. In those specific instances, it may be advantageous in the student's program of study to allow the course to fulfill a different requirement such as a studio elective or free elective.




