

Purposed Transfer Guidelines*

EMPEROR'S COLLEGE OF TRADITIONAL ORIENTAL MEDICINE

GENERAL EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS TO ENROLL AT EMPEROR'S COLLEGE

All students must have completed a minimum 60 semester units (90 quarter units) of college education prior to enrollment in the Masters Program of Oriental Medicine, with the following specific prerequisite SMC coursework:

1. English Composition: 3 units

English 1

2. Arts and Humanities: minimum 6 units from different departments, including:

Art, Music, Theatre Arts, Literature, Foreign Language, Philosophy, History

3. Mathematics: 3 units

Math 2, Math 7, Math 8, Math 21

4. Social and Behavioral Science: minimum 6 units from different departments including:

Political Science, Economics, Anthropology, Sociology, Psychology, Communications, Geography, Journalism, Women's Studies, Multi-Cultural Studies

The remainder of the 60 total units can be fulfilled with coursework of student's choosing; from classes that are CSU or UC transferable.

SMC COURSES THAT TRANSFER FOR UNIT CREDIT

The following SMC courses may be transferred to the Western Science curriculum of Emperor's College Masters of Traditional Oriental Medicine (only after the 60 unit minimum is satisfied):
