

The decision to admit/not admit a student to the designated programmes resides solely with the University.

This letter supersedes and replaces all previous arrangements between us regarding the programmes set out in this letter.

Appendix 1 – Rules of the Direct Entry Arrangement

Admissions

- All admissions to the programmes are subject to the normal admission policies of the University. The University will have sole right to decide whether to admit or not admit any prospective student. The University may at its sole discretion determine a maximum number of students it will take under this arrangement in any academic year.
- English language requirements. The University requires an IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 6.5 or better with a minimum of 6 in all sections. For students who do not meet this standard but who otherwise meet the academic standards required for entry may join an appropriate language course at the Brunel Language Centre. Following successful completion of this course, applicants will then be eligible to apply for admission to the University for an applicable programme.
- Students are strongly advised to attend Academic Induction preceding entry to the programmes and Study Skills courses during the programmes at the University.
- Applications to study at the University, and enquiries about such applications, will be made to the Admissions Team at admissions@brunel.ac.uk.
- The Institute will provide academic transcripts and other relevant certification in a timely manner in respect of student applicants.

Fees and Financial Arrangements

- Students admitted to the University will pay the appropriate annual tuition fees as specified on the University's website for the year of entry. Students will be personally responsible for all other costs and expenses incurred in studying at the University.
- Annual fees are subject to the University's tuition fee policy and may be subject to annual increases.

Publicity and Information for Students

- The arrangements for the promotion and publicity of the opportunities for direct application to the University's programmes will be the responsibility of the Institution.
- All applicable publicity and promotional materials must be pre-approved by the University's department of Communications, Marketing and Student Recruitment (CMSR) before any publication or distribution. In no event can promotional material imply any "accreditation", "recognition", "validation", "approval", "articulation", "guaranteed progression" or any similar relationship. The University will immediately terminate the arrangements in the event of any breach of this provision.
- Any use of websites web content and web design used to promote or publicise these opportunities must be approved by the University.

Mapping Exercise

- The University and the Institution have completed the mapping exercise based on their current respective course offerings. If the Institution changes its offerings it must immediately notify the University. The parties will then suspend the promotion of the applicable programme(s) until they have had the opportunity to perform a new mapping exercise. Either party can make the decision that they do not wish to carry out a new mapping exercise and in which event the relationship between the parties with respect to that programme offering shall immediately end.

General

- This letter is intended only as a statement of the intent of the University to consider individual students for admission.
- This arrangement does not preclude either party from entering into similar arrangements with other institutions.
