1. Admissions

- Applicants who have not achieved the standard of proficiency in English but who otherwise meet the
 academic standards required for entry may join an appropriate English language course at the University's
 Cheltenham International Language Centre (CILC). Following successful completion of this course, applicants
 will be eligible to proceed to the appropriate award as specified above.
- Students will be strongly advised to attend an Academic Induction preceding entry to the programmes and Study Skills courses during the programmes at UoG.
- Applications to study at the University, and enquiries about such applications, from all international students, will be made to the International Development Centre.
- All decisions as to the offer of places will be made subject to the normal admissions policies of the University.

2. Publicity and Information for Students (see appendix 3 for guidelines)

- The arrangements for promotion and publicity of opportunities for direct application onto University of Gloucestershire awards will be the responsibility of the partner
- All publicity and promotional literature relating to this agreement must be approved by the University of Gloucestershire's Department of Marketing and External Relations prior to publication and distribution. Such literature will be updated as required by the University. Please use the guidelines and letter set out in Appendix 3.
- Any website, web content and web design must be approved by UoG. All websites must be notified to the University.

3. Fees & Financial arrangements

- The students admitted to the University of Gloucestershire's programme will pay the appropriate annual tuition fee rate.
- The definitive fees will be those published on the University website for the year of entry.
- The annual fee will be subject to the tuition fee policy of the University and may be subject to annual increases.
- 4. This letter supersedes all previous arrangements pertaining to the courses detailed in this document. Where prior arrangements have a notice period this will commence on the date of this letter.
- This letter is not a legally binding document and is not an agreement between institutions. It is a statement of the intent of UoG to consider individual students for admission.
- 6. The arrangements set out in this letter are valid for one year and will then be reviewed prior to any extension. Santa Monica College will advise the University if any changes to the curriculum are made. The arrangements may be terminated by either party at any time. In the event that the University is misrepresented in publicity material then the University reserves the right to terminate the arrangements with immediate effect (see guidelines in appendix 3).
