Apply

Apply for FALL during October & November. Apply for SPRING during August.

- Complete ONE application for all CSU's at: www.calstate.edu/apply
- The Application fee is \$70 per campus. Fee Waivers available
- Do not send transcripts until you are requested to do so
- No letters of recommendation or essays required



If you are following IGETC or CSU GE, you must have it CERTIFIED by SMC prior to your transfer. Contact General Counseling/Transfer Services for more information about certification.

Coursework from other schools

- All coursework not from Santa Monica College must be evaluated by a SMC counselor to make sure they will satisfy IGETC or CSU GE requirements
- Official Transcripts from other schools must be mailed to SMC Admissions Office
