




WHAT IS THE TRANSFER PLANNER?




ACADEMIC HISTORY - ADDING COMMUNITY COLLEGES


- Must be a California Community College (CCC)
- Add as many community colleges attended/attending
- Set one as primary college
- CCC counselors will have access to your profile for advising purposes



ACADEMIC HISTORY - ADDING COURSEWORK


- Add coursework by term
- Use drop down menu to add courses
- Add completed, in progress and planned coursework
- Add standardized testing





GENERAL EDUCATION TRACKING

As you begin to enter your academic history, your courses will populate your general education progress.



- Automatically populates, but can edit assignments
- Unit count includes planned, in progress and completed courses
- Badges earned as general education requirements gets met












RESEARCHING UNIVERSITIES & PROGRAMS











TRANSFER PLANNER TO CAL STATE APPLY







- Open during application cycle
 - Spring: August 1 August 31
 - Fall: October 1 November 30
- Personal information and academic history will transfer to CSA



DUAL ADMISSION TO THE CSU

The Transfer Success Pathway (TSP) program is a transfer program that allows students to enter into an agreement with a CSU campus that guarantees admission for a future term.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Graduated high school in 2024 or prior
- No college enrollment past high school graduation
- First-time freshmen entering a community college who were:
 - Not CSU eligible at HS graduation
 - Not able to attend a CSU due to financial or personal reasons
 - Redirected and chose not to attend a CSU

HOW TO SIGN AN AGREEMENT:

- Complete admission eligibility questionnaire
- Review agreement requirements
- Select and confirm agreement
- Provide CCC information
- During the agreement cycle, August 1 September 30, agreements can be signed via the Transfer Planner
