MINIMUM ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS



- Complete 60 CSU transferable units
 - 30 must come from CSU GE course list
- At least a 2.0 GPA
- Golden 4:
 - 1 Written Communications English 1
 - 1 Critical Thinking- English 2 or 31, Bus 32, Com 21, Hist 47, Phil 7 or 9
 - <u>1 Oral Communication</u>- Com 11, 12, 16, or 21
 - <u>1 Mathematics</u> 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 10, 11, 13, 15, 21, 26, 28, 29, 54, Acct 45, Bus 45, CS 10
- Must be completed by the end of Spring before Fall transfer with a C- or better

Completion of IGETC or CSU general education pattern is recommended (Appox. 39 units in GE)



Completion of General Education

Pick One:

IGETC

- Designed for UC's & CSU's
- All courses must be completed with a grade of either a "CR" or "C"
- You can have up to 2 courses missing

CSU GE

- Designed for the CSU system
- "D" grades are acceptable (except the Golden 4, must be "C" or better)
- New area F (For students starting Fall'21 and later)
- You can receive partial certification
- You can finish certification after transfer

Transfer Tips

- ✓ Focus on Major Prep!
 - ✓ Explore each campus and major for specifics on courses you need to complete before transferring by visiting Assist.org
 - ✓ Have major prep completed by the end of Fall prior to Fall transfer
 - ✓ I.e. The semester your application is due
- ✓ For most majors, admissions is only based off courses completed & GPA
 - ✓ Pass/ No Pass
 - ✓ Not for Golden 4 or Major Prep
 - ✓ Extracurricular activities and outside activities are not considered in admissions.
- ✓ Visit a Campus!
- ✓ There is a difference between <u>competitive</u> and <u>minimum</u> requirements
 - ✓ E.g. Impaction



Impaction

When more applications are received than can be accommodated by the campus

To be admitted to an impacted major you must:

- Submit your application during the priority filing period
- Complete major requirements
- Usually have a higher GPA
- Meet any additional department requirements
- In rare cases (ex: Pomona), must be a CA resident
- Google 'CSU Impaction Matrix'

California State University System

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

- Requirements
 - Completion of CSUGE or IGETC
 - Completion of specified major requirements
 - 2.0 GPA
- Transfer Benefits
 - Guaranteed admissions to the CSU system
 - .1 Bump in your GPA
 - o E.g. 3.1 vs 3.0
 - Guaranteed graduation with 60 units after transfer
 - Possible Spring priority admission

* Important Note:

This is different than a regular Associates degree

Associate Degree for Transfer (ADT)

To receive the transfer benefits of an ADT you must:

- Declare the ADT in your CSU application
- Apply to a major that is "<u>Deemed Similar</u>"
- Complete all ADT requirements by the end of Spring before transfer for Fall admissions.
 - I.e. Your last semester at SMC

*Remember: An ADT is different from the SMC AA or AS degree

Local Area Admission Advantage







Priority Application Filing Periods:



- All Campuses
 - Fall: October 1 November 30
 - *Winter: June 1 June 30
 - Spring: August 1- August 31st

 * Most schools do not open for Winter admissions, but check with each school for details

Application/ Admissions Timeline

Fall 2023

- Apply Oct 1-November 30
- Take remaining courses
- Application workshops/labs
- Complete FAFSA starting Oct 1st

Winter 2024

- Take remaining courses (optional)
- Transfer Updates
- Continue next steps in portals
 - Ex: Application updates, supplemental applications, and official transcripts for some CSU's

Spring 2024

- Take remaining courses
- Continue next steps in portals
- Submit petition for graduation, ADT, IGETC or CSU GE
 Submit official transcripts with Spring grades

Fall 2024

• Enroll at new CSU!
